<p>Mukiseera omuntu walokokera, omukristaayo omulokole ayingira mu kugattibwa kw’Omwoyo wamu ne Yesu Kristo era asigala mu kifo ekyo emirembe n’emirembe.</p> <p>“Amazima ku kifo kyo” gwe mutwe ogusimbiddwa mu kisaawe ky’okusomesa Baibuli ku ssomo erikwaata ku kifo ky’omukristaayo omulokole mu oba okugattibwa ne Yesu Kristo.</p> <p>Okugattibwa ne Kristo kireeta emikisa mingi nnyo eri omukkiriza. Emikisa gino gisobola okukozesebwa era omukkiriza agyeyagaliramu ekiseera kyonna eky’obulamu bwe era n’okweyongerayo mu butaggwaawo.</p> <p>Ekikula kye kifo ky’omukkiriza mu Kristo kyalangirirwa Mukama waffe Yesu Kristo yennyini:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ne mukubuulira kwe mu kisenge waggulu Yok 14:20. <p>Omukristaayo agattibwa mu mwoyo okuyingira mu Kristo okuyita munkola ey’okubatizibwa kw’Omwoyo Omutukuvu. (okuyita ku mbatiza zino omusanvu eza Baibuli zituyamba okutegeera okubatizibwa kw’Omwoyo Omutukuvu).</p>	<p>At the time of his personal salvation, the Christian believer enters into a spiritual union with Jesus Christ and remains in that position forever. "Positional Truth" is the formal title for that wide class of Bible teaching on the subject of the Christian's position in or union with Jesus Christ.</p> <p>Union with Christ makes available to the believer a great number of spiritual benefits. These benefits can be used and enjoyed continuously during the believer's remaining lifetime and will continue into eternity.</p> <p>The nature of the believer's position in Christ was foretold by the Lord Jesus Himself: (1) in the Bread of Life discourse, JOHN 6:56; (2) in the Good Shepherd discourse, JOHN 10:16; and (3) in the Upper Room discourse, JOHN 14:20.</p> <p>The Christian is placed spiritually in Christ through a mechanism known as the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. These mechanics are described in 1 COR. 12:13 and GAL. 3:27,28. (A study of the seven baptisms of the Bible is a prerequisite to an understanding of the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.)</p>

This occurred for the first time on the Day of Pentecost, ACTS 2:1–4 cf. 11:15,16. Therefore, Union with Christ was experienced by believers for the first time on the Day of Pentecost, making it an experience unique to Church Age believers.</p> <p>Union with Christ is a fact for all believers,</p>

"Old things have passed away", spiritual death is done away, and "all things are become new", spiritual life is begun.</p>

The believer is identified with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection.</p>
